Super Science Sunday | April 8, 2018 | General Rules/Information:

Kids in 1-6th grade can compete for prizes. Older participants can enter as a non-competing exhibitor. One project per participant. Groups/siblings can work together on submission and share prize.

Awards given for first, second and third place, and divided into two age groups: 1-3rd grade | 4-6th grade

Projects should demonstrate some scientific principle. Consideration will be given to any "hands on" aspect of the project. Whenever possible, the project should also represent a Biblical truth. Example: "Build a switch that lights inside of dark box that visitors can activate." Explain how it works. State scripture in Genesis in which God said, "Let there be light."

Project must include some kind of informational board that explains the purpose and findings of the project.

Projects cannot be dangerous or hazardous in anyway. The use of any toxic or flammable materials is prohibited. All projects using any kind of living organism must be pre-approved. (Example: Approval needed to bring insects or pets)

Each participant will be given one half of an 8 ft. table in order to display their project. Please get prior approval if more room is required.

Alton Campus Projects must be set up no later than 8:30 AM on Sunday, April 8. Doors will open at 7:00 AM for set up. Please communicate if you need to make other arrangements. Projects will be on display between services and after the second service until 1:00 PM. Winners will be announced at that time.

Wood River Campus Projects must be set up no later than 10:30 am on Sunday, April 8. Doors will open at 9:00 AM for set up. Please communicate if you need to make other arrangements. Projects will be on display after the service until 1:00 PM. Winners will be announced at that time.

All participants must register. There is NO entry fee. Early registration is requested, but must be completed no later than Wednesday, April 4, 2018. Extra registration forms are available at the Kids Church check-in.
