Trauma Informed Care Training Event

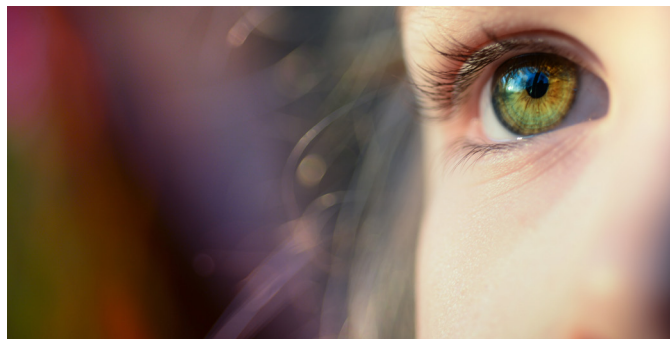
Join us for this 4 hour training designed to help ministry leaders and volunteers that work with children and teens to better understand the behaviors of children that have been through trauma.
